SMART Checklist

- **Specific** - Become more proficient in PowerPoint
- **Measurable** - Utilize PowerPoint in staff meeting presentations
- **Actionable** - By attending training programs offered, they will learn how to build a PowerPoint presentation.
- **Realistic** - The deadline for completing this task will be three months from now, which gives ample time to attend training programs, build a presentation, and present it at the next staff meeting.
- **Time Bound** - Complete by July 10, 2014, in time for next quarter’s Performance Review.
